## **SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION DEADLINES SCHEDULE**

The JAA will grant the available scholarship(s) on annual basis to the selected candidate(s). All applications must be received by October 1<sup>st</sup> of the school year. The JAA selection committee will select the recipient(s) solely based on the information provided in the submitted application and will announce its decision no later than November 1<sup>st</sup> of the school year.

### **I. APPLICATION PROCEDURES**

- A. Complete and submit to the JAA Scholarship Application Form (F1003)
- B. One page essay about yourself explaining your family background, personal interest, what you plan to study and why you want to further your education.
- C. Entering freshmen must submit an official high school transcript.
- D. Current college students must submit an official transcript of the previously attended semester.

### **II. SELECTION RECIPIENT(S)**

Selections will be based on student's overall academic progress, financial need, extracurricular activities, leadership skills, and participation in the community activities.

### **III. REVOCATION OF AID**

The JAA reserves the right to cancel any scholarship or aid awarded at any time if the applicant fails to meet the standards of academic progress, any other scholarship requirements, or falsifies information reported.
